## Joint Conference Announcement and Pre-Call for Abstracts

### **“Adapting Crops to Change” with a special joint symposium: “Technology Transfer in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century”.**

This conference will be held at the University of Saskatchewan, Saskatoon,  
Saskatchewan from

**July 16 to 19, 2012.**

Canadian Society for Horticultural Science,

Certified Crop Advisors – Prairie Board  
Agricultural Institute of Canada.

The organizing committee is pleased to announce the 2012 conference of 5 societies under the theme: “*Adapting Crops to Change*” with a special joint symposium: “*Technology Transfer in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century*” held on the beautiful campus of the University of Saskatchewan (U of S), Saskatoon, from July 16 - 19, 2012. This is the first time that the following groups are jointly meeting: Canadian Society of Agronomy (CSA), the Canadian Society for Horticultural Science (CSHS), the Certified Crop Advisors (CCA), and the North American Fruit Explorers (NAFEX). The Agricultural Institute of Canada (AIC) will also be here for part of the meetings.

“Adapting Crops to Change” signifies the importance of addressing crop improvement and adaptation not only to environmental change but to shifting world markets and consumer preferences. The special joint symposium: “Technology Transfer in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century” addresses the key issue of fast and efficient transfer of scientific knowledge to crop advisors, farmers and end users. The 2012 joint meetings features invited plenary and symposium speakers, contributed papers (oral presentations and posters), competitive presentations for graduate students, society annual meetings, and offsite tours. The magnificent campus of the University of Saskatchewan is located along the banks of the South Saskatchewan river and is composed of 12 Colleges, a vibrant student community of 20,000+ and world class facilities.

The official call for abstracts and papers will be announced soon. Members will be encouraged to submit titles and abstracts of papers and posters to be presented at sessions sponsored by their society. Each society is also hosting a Graduate Student Presentation Competition. All abstracts will be published in the colloquium proceedings and on the joint meeting website.

**Canadian Journal of Plant Science Special Issue.** The topics covered in “Adapting Crops to Change” meeting that contain new information of national or international significance within the scope of the journal are eligible for publication. The participants, who are presenting scientific papers, including posters, are invited to submit reviews and papers for publication. The MS should describe

the original work of the authors that have not been published in a peer-reviewed journal and is not under consideration for publication elsewhere. Submission of papers for publication in the Canadian Journal of Plant Science is optional.
