
Your membership provides the following benefits and more:

- A complimentary subscription to the electronic editions of the <u>Canadian Journal of</u> <u>Plant Science</u> (CJPS) as a CSHS member.
- Reduced page charges to publish in the Canadian Journal of Plant Science (CJPS): \$30 per page for members, \$90 per page for non-members.



- Significantly reduced registration fees at the annual CSHS/SCSH conferences with cost savings that can be far more than the annual membership fees. For example, for the upcoming conference in meeting in Kelowna (June 23-26, 2025), members will save \$100 for registration.
- For students: An offer in which they can **become a member of three societies**; <u>Canadian Society of Agronomy (CSA)</u>, <u>Canadian Society of Soil Science (CSSS)</u>, as well as our <u>CSHS</u> for the <u>reduced annual registration fee of \$60</u>.
- Timely direct email alerts to jobs, grant opportunities, etc.

 Only CSHS members will be sent regular issues of Chronica
 Horticulturae, the International Society for Horticulture Science magazine. Interesting articles on international horticulture, dates of upcoming international conferences, etc. are featured.



- Only registered members are eligible for **awards**:
 - **Student awards** for oral presentations, poster presentations, and travel. Since we are a smaller society, the possibility for winning awards is much higher than some larger societies.
 - Most Cited Paper Award in Canadian Journal of Plant Science.
 - Invitation to be a conference speaker with the possibility of waived registration and accommodation costs.
- Financial support of CSHS student activities across Canada.

Horticulture is an important sector in Canada's economy. You are involved in many important horticulture activities and would like to see this sector to grow. Our society provides a platform for this, and many of our efforts are geared towards supporting our students, the new generation of horticulture experts and scientists. The CSHS needs your energy, enthusiasm and commitment to horticulture in Canada.


Our **Regular** membership fee is just **\$90 per year**. There are currently even more savings for 2-year (\$170), 3-year (\$225) and 5-year regular memberships (\$425). **Student** memberships are only **\$30 per year**, or \$60 per year to join three societies (CSHS, CSA, CSSS). **Postdoctoral Fellow** membership is **\$60 per year** and **Retired** members have a special rate of **\$30 per year**.

Our **Corporate** membership fee is only **\$360 per year**. Each Corporate membership also includes five complimentary regular memberships worth \$90 each for a total value of \$450.

All the rates are in Canadian Dollars; payments are easy and can be completed online by PayPal, E-transfer, or cheque payable to the Canadian Society for Horticultural Science (www.cshs.ca/membership).

Here are some highlights of our 2024 activities:

- The CSHS participated in the Plant
 Canada 2024 Conference held July 710, 2024 in Winnipeg, Manitoba. This
 was a reunion of seven Canadian plant
 science societies and provided an
 opportunity for productive scientific
 exchange among participants from
 across Canada. CSHS student members
 received six presentation awards (oral
 and poster) for a total of \$2000.
- CSHS members are preparing a
 Horticulture Special Issue entitled
 Emerging Trends in Horticulture for
 the February 2025 issue of the
 Canadian Journal of Plant Science. Drs.
 Melanie Kalischuk, Lord Abbey and
 Raphael Ofoe are as guest co-editors of
 this special issue.



Graduate student Ifesinachi Nelson Ezeh <u>received</u> third place for his poster from both the Canadian Society of Horticultural Sciences and the Canadian Phytopathological Society at Plant Canada 2024.

- The society is actively preparing for the **CSHS & CSA 2025 Joint Conference** which will be held on June 23-26, 2025 in Kelowna, BC.
